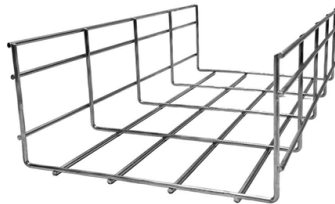

Aggregation switches use IGMP to efficiently manage multicast traffic, preventing unnecessary flooding and optimizing network performance. What is an Aggregation Switch? An aggregation switch consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers. It operates at Layer 2 or Layer 3, depending on the network design, and supports link aggregation protocols like LACP or static link aggregation to combine multiple physical links into a single logical connection, enhancing bandwidth, redundancy, and failover capability. Aggregation switches are commonly deployed in enterprise backbones, data centers, and large campus networks to streamline traffic and reduce bottlenecks.

Role of IGMP in Aggregation Switches

IGMP (Internet Group Management Protocol) is used to manage multicast group memberships on a LAN. Hosts use IGMP to inform switches and routers about their interest in receiving specific multicast traffic. Aggregation switches often implement IGMP snooping, which allows the switch to monitor IGMP messages and forward multicast traffic only to ports with interested hosts, rather than flooding all ports. This improves network efficiency and reduces unnecessary bandwidth usage.

Key IGMP Features in Aggregation Switches

- IGMP Snooping:** Monitors IGMP join/leave messages to optimize multicast delivery.
- Multicast VLANs:** Some switches allow multicast traffic to be isolated in dedicated VLANs for better performance.
- IGMP Proxy:** Enables hosts not directly connected to a router to join multicast groups sourced from upstream networks.
- Version Support:** Modern aggregation switches support IGMPv2 and IGMPv3, allowing tracking of individual hosts and source-specific multicast (SSM) control.
