Laying Cables Organized Placement: Lay cables in an orderly manner, avoiding excessive bending to prevent insulation damage. Spacing: Maintain proper separation between cables to reduce heat buildup and allow for future maintenance. For multicore cables, surfaces should be separated by at least 50–75 mm depending on size and grouping. Cable Fill: Do not exceed 40% of tray capacity to ensure adequate ventilation and prevent overheating. Identification: Use markers for cable identification at regular intervals to facilitate maintenance. Securing and Bonding Fix cables at regular intervals using cable ties or clamps, ensuring they are not overly tight to avoid crushing insulation.
