

Assembly and Wiring Method of Secondary Distribution Box

Wiring Procedure

Incoming power connection: Connect the feeder cable from the main panel to the main isolation switch of the sub panel.

Branch circuit wiring: Connect each branch circuit to its respective breaker. Typically, wiring from the main breaker to branch breakers is routed on the left, and outgoing circuits on the right.

Cable management: Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, maintaining uniform spacing and avoiding kinks or ribs.

Marking: Clearly label AC/DC lines, voltage levels, and circuit designations for safety and maintenance.

Grounding: Ensure all metal parts and the ground bus are properly connected to the building's grounding system.

Safety and Inspection

- Perform a visual inspection to check for loose connections, proper insulation, and correct breaker placement.
- Use a multimeter to verify voltage, continuity, and absence of short circuits.
