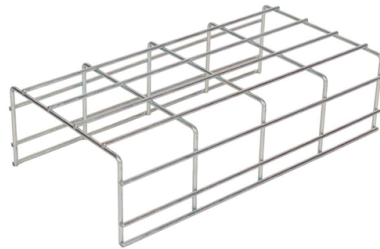


Blue light on the distribution box



Overview

Issue: Overheating can occur when the distribution board is overloaded or when there are faulty connections, which increases the risk of fire. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. Using the correct wiring color codes is crucial for identifying line, neutral, and ground wires, which saves time, simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting, and ensures the safety of.
