

Cable Binding in Ladder-Type Cable Trays

Best Practices

- Minimum Bend Radius:** Ensure cables are not bent sharply at entry or exit points to prevent damage.
- Rung Spacing:** Typical ladder rungs are spaced 150–230 mm apart, providing convenient anchor points for ties or bands.
- Bundle Cables by Type:** Separate power, control, and data cables to reduce electromagnetic interference and simplify maintenance.
- Allow for Thermal Expansion:** Leave slight slack in long runs to accommodate expansion and contraction of cables due to temperature changes.
- Compliance with Standards:** Follow BS EN 61537 or equivalent local standards for cable support systems to ensure safety and mechanical integrity.

Additional Considerations

- Vertical Runs:** Use stronger restraints such as metal banding or multiple ties to prevent cables from sliding.
- Future Expansion:** Avoid over-tight bundling; leave space for additional cables if the system may be expanded.
