These standards cover manufacturing, shipping, handling, storage, installation, and maintenance, as well as load/span class designations. Nonmetallic Tray Standards Nonmetallic trays must comply with UL 568, which defines construction and testing requirements for continuous systems of ladder, ventilated, solid bottom, or channel-type trays. These standards ensure that nonmetallic trays can safely support power and control cables under typical operating conditions.
