

Cable Tray Laying Techniques

For elbows, expansion joints, or long outdoor runs, provide additional supports and expansion connectors as per NEMA VE 2 standards. Ensure trays are level, straight, and securely fastened, allowing for longitudinal movement where necessary.

Cable Laying Techniques Lay cables neatly within the tray, using cable ties or straps to separate by voltage, function, or type. Maintain minimum bend radius and leave slack for expansion or future adjustments. Avoid placing connectors at the center of spans; position them between support points or at quarter points to reduce stress.

Grounding and Bonding For metal trays, bonding and grounding are essential. Install bonding jumpers at expansion joints and ground trays at regular intervals (e.g., every 15 meters) to maintain electrical continuity and safety. Ensure conduit drop-outs are bonded to the tray using proper lugs or bushings.
