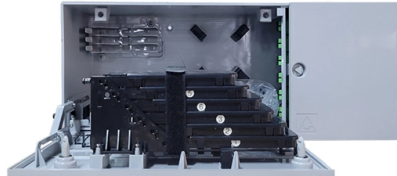


Cable routing in cable trays

Routing Methods

- Horizontal Routing:** Cables run along the same plane using straight sections of trays. Horizontal bends (30° , 45° , 90°) allow direction changes without stressing cables.
- Vertical Routing (Risers):** Cables move between elevations using vertical bends or risers. Drop-outs allow cables to exit the tray vertically to connect to equipment.
- Branching:** Tees and crosses create branches from the main tray to distribute cables to different areas. Reducers connect trays of different widths for main-to-branch transitions.
- Bundling and Separation:** Use cable ties, straps, or sleeves to organize cables by type, voltage, or function. Maintain separation between power and data lines to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI).
- Ceiling or Wall Mounting:** Trays can be mounted overhead or along walls to keep cables unobtrusive and safe from floor hazards. Supports like trapeze hangers, wall brackets, or center-span supports maintain stability.
- Slack and Expansion:** Leave sufficient slack for thermal expansion, movement, or future adjustments. Proper bend radius must be...
