Common cover types include: Flat covers: Ideal for indoor corridors and data centers where space is limited and aesthetics matter. Dome-shaped (hat) covers: Designed to shield overfilled trays and deflect falling debris, suitable for outdoor or overhead installations. Peaked or corrugated covers: Reinforced for outdoor use, providing structural strength without adding excessive weight. Finned covers: Enhance ventilation in industrial control panels. Hinged covers: Allow quick access for maintenance while maintaining protection. Material selection is important for durability and corrosion resistance.
