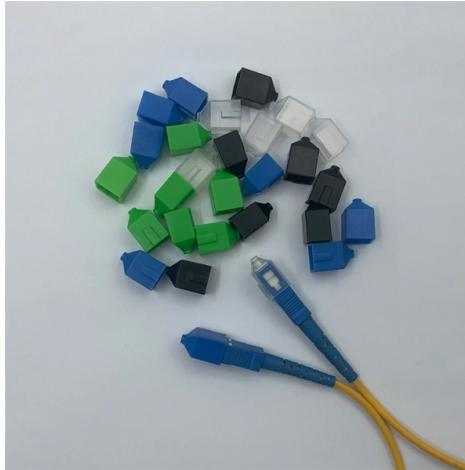


Can a network cable be used without connecting a fiber optic pigtail
