It ensures mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, and electrical continuity for safe cable support in electrical installations. NEMA VE 1 and VE 2 are U.S. standards for metal cable trays, covering manufacturing, installation, load/span designations, and maintenance. VE 1 applies to steel or aluminum trays, including ladder, channel, single-rail, wire mesh, and solid bottom types, harmonized with the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) for cross-border compliance. UL 568 addresses nonmetallic (fiberglass) cable trays, defining construction and performance requirements for safe application. IEC and NEMA standards guide engineers, contractors, and manufacturers in ensuring compatibility, safety, and long-term reliability.

Types of Cable Trays

- Ladder Tray:** Open design for power and control cables, allows ventilation and heat dissipation.
- Ventilated Trough/Channel Tray:** Provides partial protection with perforated or solid bottoms, suitable for instrumentation and control cables.
- Wire Mesh Tray:** Lightweight, flexible, and ideal for complex routing or retrofit installations.
- Solid Bottom Tray:** Offers maximum protection against dust, moisture, and electromagnetic interference.

Cable Tray Colour Codes

Color-coding enhances safety, identification, and operational efficiency. Standard practices assign specific colors to cable types:

- Orange:** Critical or emergency circuits
- Red:** Fire alarm or safety circuits
- Blue:** Communication or data cables
- Green/Yellow:** Grounding or protective earth
- Black:** General power distribution
