- Conduit Installation:** Lay PVC or metallic conduits inside the grooves, ensuring proper alignment and spacing. PVC is lightweight and corrosion-resistant, while metallic conduits offer stronger mechanical protection.
- Wire Pulling and Connections:** Pull wires through the conduits using fish tape, strip insulation, and make connections following color codes. Grounding wires must be connected as required.
- Testing:** Verify all circuits, switches, and outlets for proper function before covering the conduits.
- Concealing and Finishing:** Cover the conduits and boxes with plaster, cement, or wall finishes. Install cover plates on junction boxes to maintain accessibility.
- Spacing and Accessibility** Draw boxes or junction boxes should be installed at intervals not exceeding 9 meters (30 feet) along straight conduit runs.
- Right-angle bends** between boxes should not exceed two to facilitate wire pulling
