

Configure the IP address for the optical module



AI Overview

To configure the IP of an optical module, connect it to a computer or router via Ethernet, access its management interface, and assign a static or DHCP IP according to your network settings.

Step 1: Hardware Connection Insert the optical module (e.g., SFP+, XGSPON ONU Stick) into the appropriate port on your router, switch, or optical device, ensuring it is firmly seated. Connect the fiber-optic cable to the module, making sure the connectors are clean and undamaged. Some devices may require a reboot after installation to recognize the module.

Step 2: Access the Management Interface Use a computer with an Ethernet interface connected to the module or the router/switch port hosting the module. Open a web browser or terminal to access the module's management interface. For some modules, this may involve entering a default IP address or using a serial console connection. Log in using the default credentials provided by the manufacturer (e.g., Cisco/Cisco for Cisco devices).

Step 3: Assign IP Address Determine whether your network uses DHCP or static IP. For static IP configuration, enter the IP address, subnet mask, and default gateway in the module's interface. For DHCP, enable the DHCP option so the module automatically receives an IP from your network. Some modules, like Cisco NCS 1001, may have dedicated Ethernet ports (UDC ports) for management, which are statically associated with specific slots.

Step 4: Verify Configuration Use commands or the web interface to check the module's IP and connectivity. For Cisco devices, commands like `show interface` or `show interface status` display link status, IP assignment, and transceiver details. For Huawei devices, commands like `display transceiver interface` provide diagnostic and IP-related information.

Step 5: Troubleshooting Ensure the fiber and Ethernet connections are secure and clean. Verify that the IP address doe...
