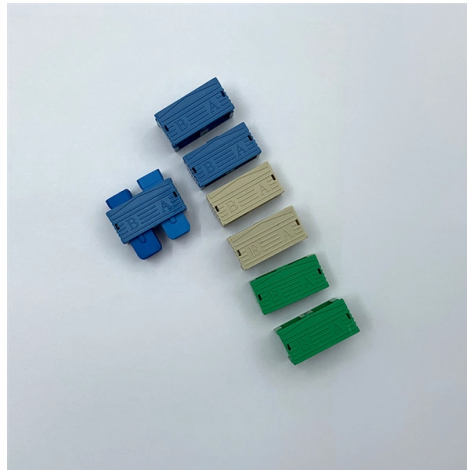

Modules are inserted into the switch's SFP ports and must match the fiber type and network speed (1G, 10G, or higher). Fiber Optic Cables: Duplex fiber cables with LC connectors are commonly used. Pre-terminated cables simplify installation, while bulk fiber requires field termination. Couplers or Patch Panels: Optional devices like LC-LC couplers can connect two fiber cables with minimal signal loss. Connection Process Insert the SFP modules into the SFP ports on each switch. Connect the duplex fiber cable, ensuring the send and receive strands are reversed between the two switches (A to B, B to A) to allow proper communication. Configure the switch interfaces if necessary. Unlike copper Ethernet, fiber SFP ports may require enabling the interface (e.g., no shutdown on VLAN interfaces) to activate the link. Advantages of Using Fiber High Bandwidth: Fiber supports higher data rates than copper cables, reducing congestion in networks with heavy traffic. Long Distance: Single-mode fiber can transmit over kilometers without signal degradation, ideal for connecting switches across building...
