The three components of this packing configuration are the carrier tape, the cover tape, and the reel. A description of each component is provided in the following paragraphs.

Surface Mount

Surface Mount - Tape & Reel Tape-and-Reel is one of the primary methods for shipping surface mount devices. This system simplifies the handling of semiconductors for automated circuit board assembly

Tape and Reel Packaging

A row of sprocket holes is provided along one edge of the embossed tape to facilitate positive indexing. The tape is then wound onto a rigid plastic reel that provides mechanical protection during handling

IEC Standard specifies tape and reel requirements

The tape is wound around a reel and can be loaded onto automatic placement machines used for the assembly of electronic devices. This process is known as tape and reel.
