- Government initiatives:** National broadband plans and smart city projects accelerate fiber network deployment globally.

- Single-mode fiber (ITU-T G.657.A2)** dominates access networks, accounting for 60% of new deployments.
- Transmission capacity** has increased from 100 Tbps in 2018 to 800 Tbps in 2023, with Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM) used in 90% of long-haul networks.
- Advanced fiber designs** such as ribbon fibers, micro-cables, and high-density systems are increasingly adopted to meet growing bandwidth demands.
