5. Vandalism or Intentional Damage Deliberate tampering or vandalism can also lead to cable cuts, disrupting communication networks and requiring immediate repair .

Repair and Prevention When a break occurs, operators typically locate the fault using Optical Time Domain Reflectometry (OTDR) or visual inspection. Repairs may involve fusion splicing or mechanical splicing, and in severe cases, replacing the damaged cable section entirely . Preventive strategies include proper cable routing, protectiv...
