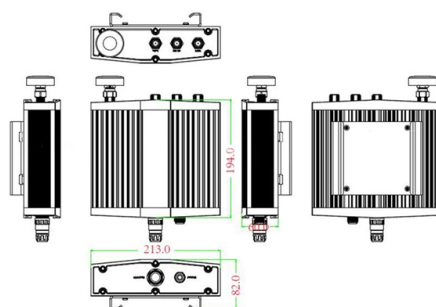

It is widely used in data centers, enterprise core networks, and telecom infrastructure due to its high port density, standardized interface. A 100G optical module is a high-speed communication device designed for data centers and telecommunication networks, capable of supporting transmission rates of 100 Gbps. These modules convert electric signals into optical signals, enabling efficient data transmission over optical fibers. 25G is the new 10G; 100G (QSFP28) is the workhorse; design for migration plans to 400G/800G.
