A distribution box (DB box) typically includes circuit breakers, residual current devices, isolators, bus bars, neutral and ground links, and optional monitoring or transfer switches to safely distribute and protect electrical circuits.

Core Components of a Distribution Box

- Main Switch / Main Circuit Breaker:** Controls the entire electrical supply to the DB box and allows complete disconnection during maintenance or emergencies.
- Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits by automatically tripping when abnormal current is detected.

- Isolators / Disconnect Switches:** Manually operated devices that safely isolate circuits for maintenance or emergency purposes.
- Bus Bars:** Metal strips that conduct electricity within the box, serving as central connection points for all circuits.
- Neutral and Ground Bars:** Provide return paths for current and ensure proper grounding of the electrical system.
- Fuses:** Older DB boxes may use fuses instead of breakers; they blow when current exceeds a limit, cutting off power to prevent damage.
- Bypass Equipment:** Allows testing or repair of circuits without affecting other parts of the system.
- Transfer Switch / Automatic Transfer Switch (ATS):** Switches power between the main supply and backup sources like generators, ensuring continuous power in critical setups.
