In the 2023 NEC, 408.4 (B) requires marking on switchboards, switchgear, and panelboards (supplied by a feeder) to indicate where the power originates, as well as its physical location.

408.4(B) Field Identification Required. Source of Supply.

Now, switchboards, switchgear, and panelboards supplied by feeders in other than one- or two-family dwellings must be marked to indicate each device or equipment where the power originates.
