Overview of Double-Pole Breakers

A double-pole breaker is essentially two single-pole breakers combined into one unit, occupying two slots in a distribution panel. It connects to both hot wires (L1 and L2) in a 240V circuit, ensuring that if an overload or short circuit occurs on either line, both poles trip simultaneously, cutting off power to the entire circuit.

In single-phase domestic distribution boxes, a 2P breaker is often used as the main switch or for special high-power loads such as air conditioners, water heaters, pumps, or EV chargers.

Wiring in a Distribution Box

In a typical single-phase distribution box:

- Incoming Supply:** The phase (L) and neutral (N) wires from the main supply are connected to the upper terminals of the double-pole breaker.
- Outgoing Supply:** The lower terminals provide power to the branch circuits or loads.
- Neutral and Earth:** The neutral wire is connected to the neutral busbar, and the protective earth (PE) is connected to the ground busbar. For 2P breakers, both line and neutral are disconnected when the breaker trips, enhancing safety during maintenance.

Double-pole breakers have four terminals: two for incoming supply and two for outgoing supply. They can also be used for DC supply switching or controlling single-phase machines and motors.

Applications

- Residential:** Main MCB in single-phase distribution boards, high-power appliances, subpanels, and specialized outlets. Typical ratings range from 15A to 63A.
- Commercial/Industrial:** Heavy-duty circuits, HVAC systems, industrial machinery, and multi-wire branch circuits, with ratings up to 100A or more.
