Step 4: Connect the Patch Cord Align the connector with the port on the patch panel. Gently insert the connector until it clicks or seats securely. Avoid forcing the connector, as this can damage the fiber. For angled physical contact (APC) connectors, ensure the correct orientation to maintain low insertion loss.

Step 5: Manage and Label Cables Use cable management tools such as Velcro ties, trays, or guides to route the patch cords neatly. Label each cord to identify its connection points, which simplifies troubleshooting and future upgrades.
