- Install Transceivers:** Insert the module into the switch port; most are hot-swappable, so the switch does not need to be powered down.
- Connect Fiber Cables:** Attach the fiber cable to the transceiver, ensuring the connectors (e.g., LC, SC) match and are clean to prevent signal loss.
- Patch Panel Integration:** If using a patch panel, connect the other end of the fiber to the panel, which then links to the main network or another switch.
- Verify Connections:** Ensure duplex fiber connections are correctly reversed between send and receive ports (A to B, B to A) for proper communication.

- Star Topology:** All switches connect to a central hub or switch, ideal for high-performance networks with minimal collisions.
