Damage to the fiber core or cladding can result in signal attenuation, modal dispersion, and complete signal failure. Even a small nick in a single-mode fiber can reduce its effective transmission distance by half, potentially disrupting services for entire neighborhoods or critical operations like telemedicine and financial trading.
