

Fiber optic cable entry point for communication equipment room



Overview

Backbone cabling provides high-capacity interconnections between entrance facilities, equipment rooms, and telecommunications rooms. It typically consists of fiber optic or high-performance copper cabling, supporting gigabit and terabit speeds for large-scale enterprise networks. Fiber optics is also a horizontal option in TIA 568, but not often used because of the higher cost of electronics. The exception is where high bitrate networks or future upgrades are expected. 1 defines the entrance facility (building entrance) as the point in the building where cabling connects to the outside world.
