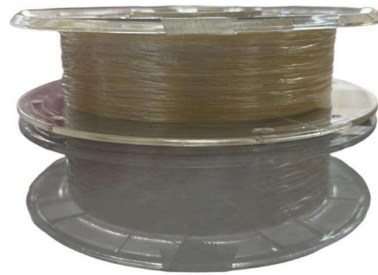

Troubleshooting Steps Check for ISP Outages Visit your ISP's website or social media pages to see if there is a known service disruption. Inspect Fiber Cables and Connections Look for visible damage, sharp bends, or loose connectors. Ensure the fiber cable is properly seated in the router's WAN/ONT port. Reboot Your Router Turn off the router, unplug it from the power source for 30 seconds, then reconnect and power it on. This can often restore the signal. Check Router Placement and Ventilation Ensure the router is not overheating by placing it in a well-ventilated area and cleaning dust from vents. Test or Replace Hardware If the LOS light persists, test the router or ONT with a known-good unit, or contact your ISP to check the optical power levels and replace faulty equipment if necessary. When to Call Your ISP If the LOS light remains red after checking cables, rebooting, and ensuring proper router placement, the issue may be outside your home, such as a damaged fiber line or a...
