- Scalability:** Fiber can support future upgrades, including emerging technologies like hollow-core fiber, which reduces latency by up to 30% compared to conventional fiber.

Economic and Maintenance Considerations

Although initial deployment costs for fiber can be higher than copper, long-term savings are significant. Fiber networks require less maintenance, fewer field visits, and lower operational costs. For example, an all-fiber network can save \$91 per home per year compared to DSL, accumulating to \$910 over a decade. Copper networks also require ongoing upkeep, such as battery maintenance, corrosion prevention, and protection against environmental damage.
