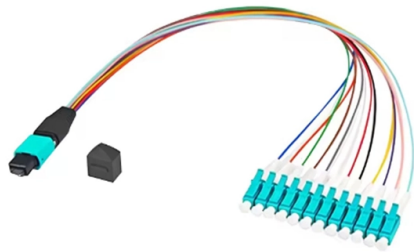


Fiber optic connection to Lebanon branch



AI Overview

Lebanon is actively expanding its fiber optic network, with FTTH and FTTC deployments aiming to provide high-speed internet to over 325,000 homes within the next 16-24 months. Current Rollout Status Lebanon's fiber optic project, initially launched in 2018, faced delays due to the economic crisis and regional conflicts. The government has now resumed the rollout, with funding allocated in the 2024 and 2025 budgets. Ogero, the state-owned telecom operator, has issued tenders for importing cables, equipment, and installation work, targeting major cities first, particularly households already equipped with DSL boxes, and expects completion within 16-24 months.

Network Architecture and Technology

The Lebanese fiber network uses FTTX architectures, including:

- FTTH (Fiber to the Home):** Fiber runs directly to residences, enabling speeds from 100 Mbps up to 1 Gbps.
- FTTC (Fiber to the Cabinet):** Fiber reaches street cabinets, with copper completing the last segment. This ensures minimum speeds of 50 Mbps.

The network relies on GPON (Gigabit Passive Optical Network) technology, which allows a single OLT (Optical Line Terminal) port to serve multiple subscribers via passive splitters. Typical configurations use 1:8, 1:16, or 1:32 split ratios, supporting hundreds of users per OLT port while maintaining service quality.

Equipment and Deployment

Key components for Lebanese ISPs include:

- OLT (Optical Line Terminal):** Aggregates subscriber connections at the ISP's central office. High-capacity OLTs with 10G or 25G uplinks are used for core network connectivity.
- ODN (Optical Distribution Network):** Passive fiber infrastructure including trunk cables, splitters, and drop cables connecting OLTs to subscribers.
- ONU/ONT (Optical Network Unit/Terminal):** Converts optical signals to Ethernet for end-user devices. Auto-discovery and remote management protocols like TR-069 are implemented for efficient subscriber activation.
