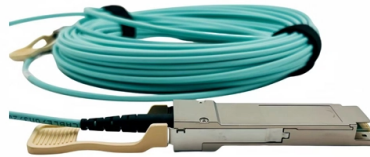

- Router Compatibility:** Not all routers can directly accept fiber input. Most setups require an ONT or modem to interface between the fiber line and the router.
- Wi-Fi Performance:** Using a modern router (Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 6e) ensures optimal speed and low latency for streaming, gaming, and multiple devices.
- Placement:** Position the router centrally to maximize wireless coverage and avoid interference from walls or electronic devices.
