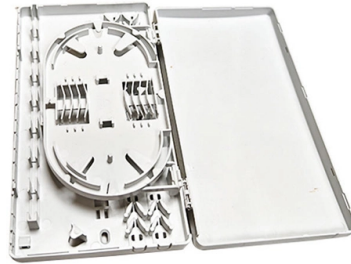


Georgia power distribution box explosion



Overview

ATLANTA — Georgia Power is making final repairs following an underground fire in midtown Atlanta that left thousands without power for several hours. The fire began more than 20 hours ago due to an equipment failure related to a distribution line in an underground vault, as reported. Starting in June, a decrease of around \$50 per year for the typical residential customer is part of approximately \$285 million in yearly savings statewide.
