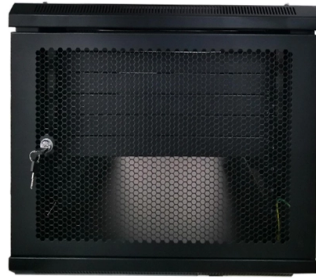

Push the connector in until it clicks securely, ensuring a stable optical connection. Handle the fiber carefully to avoid contamination or damage, using gloves and cleaning tools if necessary. Linking the ONT to a Router Once the ONT receives the optical signal: Use a high-speed Ethernet cable (CAT6 or better) to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet output port to the WAN/Internet port on your router. Ensure the router is powered and positioned in a dry, ventilated area with surge protection. Power on the ONT first to allow it to establish a connection with the provider's Optical Line Terminal (OLT), then power the router.
