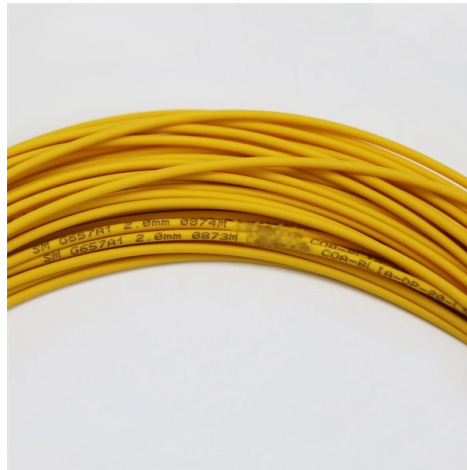

Practical Implications Performance limitation: The connection will be capped at 1Gbps, so the 10G module's speed advantage is lost. Network stability: Using mismatched modules can cause errors or instability, especially in high-performance environments. Recommendation: For optimal performance, it is best to match the module speed to the port speed. If a 10G module is required, the port should support 10GbE (SFP+). Conversely, if only 1GbE is needed, a standard SFP module is sufficient. Summary While some 10G optical modules can physically fit and operate at 1Gbps in Gigabit ports, this setup does not leverage the 10G speed and may introduce compatibility issues. A: No. The physical circuit of the 1G module only supports 1.25Gbps signal. Forcing the SFP+ port to 10G mode will result in: port error, link failure, and even damage to the module in extreme cases.
