

## Grounding of the three-switch distribution box



### Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be  $< 1 \Omega$ . Grounding is a mechanism to protect distribution equipment and people under normal operating conditions, abnormal operational (overcurrent and overvoltage) responses, and hazardous conditions such as shocks. Grounding is necessary to assure correct operation of electrical devices, to assure safety. IPMENT, STRUCTURES, ETC. IN ELECTRICAL STATIONS INCLUDING TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION SUBSTAT GR THAN 8 FT FROM THE FENCE. THE FENCE SHALL BE GROUNDED SEPARATELY FROM THE GRID UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ON THE A PROPRIATE PROJECT DRAWING. This helps to reduce the potential difference that exists between conductive parts and the earth. Equipment Protection: Grounding protects substation. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm<sup>2</sup> (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm<sup>2</sup> must be used. Can I extend the current ground wire to the other two switches?

Can I do this by connecting all 3 ground terminals together with ground wires?
