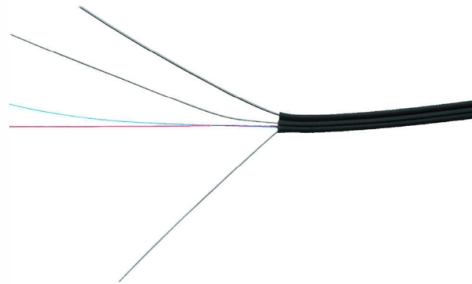


Height requirements for vertically arranged electrical distribution boxes
