High and low voltage switchboards are essential components for safely distributing electrical power, with HV switchboards handling voltages above 1 kV and LV switchboards managing voltages up to 600 V.

Low Voltage (LV) Switchboards LV switchboards, also called distribution boards, distribute low-voltage power to facility circuits and protect against overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults. They typically include main distribution boards (MDBs), sub-main distribution boards (SMDBs), and final distribution boxes (FDBs). MDBs manage power from one or more sources and provide circuit breakers for each branch circuit, while SMDBs distribute electricity to specific zones, and FDBs supply power to end-user devices like lighting, HVAC, or appliances (). LV switchboards often integrate air circuit breakers (ACBs) and molded case circuit breakers (MCCBs) for protection and may allow modular expansion for future needs ().

High Voltage (HV) Switchboards HV switchboards, or HV cubicles, handle voltages above 1 kV and up to 52 kV. They are prefabricated, metal-enclosed units containing switchgear such as circuit breakers, disconnectors, and contactors, enabling disconnection, protection, and control functions (). HV switchboards must comply with IEC 62271-200 for AC metal-enclosed switchgear, and their components follow standards like IEC 62271-100 for high-voltage AC circuit breakers and IEC 62271-102 for disconnectors and earthing switches (). HV cubicles can be fixed or withdrawable (draw-out), with draw-out types allowing maintenance without shutting down the entire system ().
