

How a low-voltage electrician installs cable trays

- Ceiling-suspended:** Using threaded rods or hangers.
- Floor-supported:** Using stands or pedestals for heavy or long runs.

Supports should maintain tray alignment, level, and prevent sagging.

- Align and level:** Ensure straight runs and proper slope for drainage if required.
- Secure trays:** Tighten all fasteners and verify stability.
- Cable laying:** Pull cables carefully to avoid damage, respecting minimum bend radius and fill capacity.
