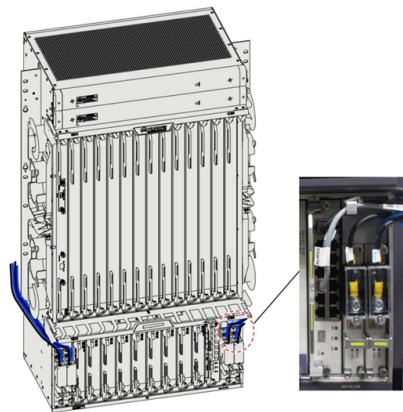

- Routing:** Follow the shortest practical path to reduce cable length, avoid unnecessary bends, and prevent congestion. Multi-level layouts or bridges can prevent crossovers.
- Support and Mounting:** Use wall brackets, suspended supports, or center suspensions to secure trays. Ensure mechanical stability and compliance with load ratings.
- Environmental Considerations:** Select materials and designs suitable for the environment.
