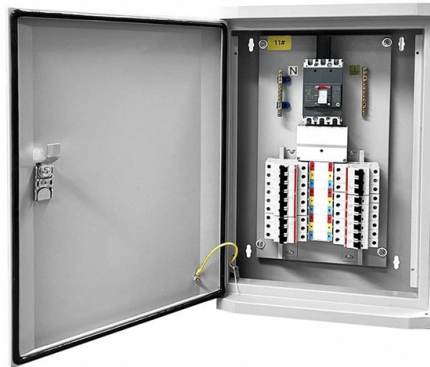


How are wires connected in cable trays
