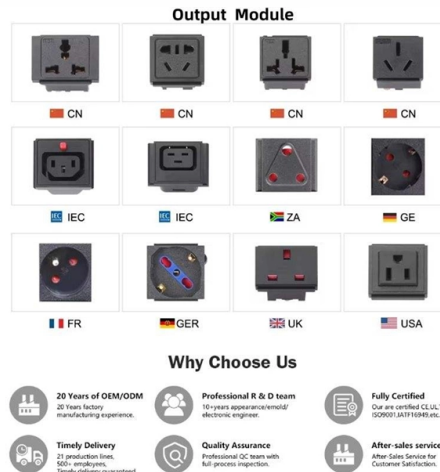


How big does a standard network cabinet need
