NEC Compliance According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) 408.54, the number of installed breakers must not exceed the panel's listed capacity, and panels must not be overcrowded. The NEC no longer sets a fixed maximum number of breakers; instead, it defers to the manufacturer's specifications. Panels must also maintain proper spacing and allow for future expansion, typically limiting usage to 80% of the full rated capacity for safety.

Practical Examples A 100-amp panel may allow 20 circuits with a maximum of 24 branch circuits using tandem breakers. A 200-amp panel commonly has 40 slots, which can be expanded with tandem breakers to accommodate more circuits, depending on the panel's design.
