When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. In cases where a tray is not strong enough to hold the mass of the weight it contains, it. National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies the capacities of cables rated at 2000 volts or less in cable trays.
