Bypass or Redundancy Devices: Specialized hardware like bypass switches can allow multiple routers to share a single ONT port for redundancy, though this is more common in enterprise setups.

Bandwidth and Performance Fiber optic connections provide high bandwidth, but the total network performance depends on the routers' capabilities and the number of devices connected. Each router adds potential latency and network management complexity.
