

How many watts does a single switch in a secondary distribution box have



Overview

Using the formula Amps equals Watts divided by Volts, a 15-amp switch on a 120-volt system can safely handle 1,800 watts of load. The switch itself provides a secondary, often lower, wattage limit that must be respected, even if the circuit breaker capacity is. For a 15-amp, 120-volt circuit, the maximum continuous power allowed is 1,440 watts ($15 \text{ A} \times 120 \text{ V} \times 0.8$). In North American residential wiring, the standard voltage is 120 volts, which is the potential difference that drives the current through a circuit. Examples of 15A are NEMA 14-15R, 5-15R, 6-15R and 14-50R etc. Example of 20A outlets are NEMA 2-20R. I have a switch that has "3A 250VAC" and "5A 125VAC" printed on it, which I imagine are ratings of what the switch can handle, but my understanding that 3A at 250V would be 750W and that 5A at 125V would be 625W so I'm confused about how the ratings correlate.
