

How to check the fiber optic interface on a router

A port showing "up" status confirms it is operational, while "down" indicates a problem.

Detailed Interface Information To get more detailed information about a specific fiber port: Use `show interface` to view speed, duplex mode, and error counters. For transceiver details, use `show interface transceiver` or `show interface transceiver detail` if your SFP supports Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM). Note that non-DOM SFPs may not provide diagnostic data.

Testing Signal Strength For precise testing, you can use a fiber optic power meter or an Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS): Connect one end of the fiber to the optical source and the other to the meter. Measure the transmitted and received power levels to calculate optical loss. Proper readings indicate a healthy connection. A visual fault locator can also help detect breaks or bends by shining light through the fiber and observing scattering points.
