

How to connect a transceiver to an optical module

- Verify Connection:** Check that the link is active and the device recognizes the module. If the module is hot-swappable, this can be done without powering down the device.

Maintenance and Removal

- Disconnect Fiber First:** Always remove the fiber connector before extracting the module to prevent damage.
- Replace Dust Caps:** Cover the module and fiber ends with dust caps when not in use to prevent contamination.
- Handle Carefully:** Slide the module out using the pull tab, avoiding contact with metal surfaces, and allow it to cool if it has been operating at high temperatures.
