

How to connect the core switch cable

Core switch cables should be connected using the correct ports and cable types, typically fiber optic or Ethernet, following proper network topology to ensure stability and performance.

Choosing the Right Cable Type

Fiber Optic Cables: Ideal for long-distance connections between buildings or data closets. Use pre-terminated multi-strand fiber cables with LC or SFP connectors for ease of installation and minimal signal loss. Fiber is preferred for future-proofing and high-speed uplinks.

Ethernet Cables: Suitable for shorter distances (under 100 meters). Use Cat 6 or higher for gigabit speeds. Copper cables are cost-effective for connecting edge switches within the same building.

Connecting the Cables

Identify the Ports: Core switches often have SFP or SFP+ ports for fiber connections and standard RJ45 ports for Ethernet. Ensure you use the correct port type for your cable.

Insert Transceivers: For fiber connections, insert the optical transceiver into the switch port, then connect the fiber cable to the transceiver. Ensure the transmit (TX) and receive (RX) ends are correctly aligned.

Ethernet Connections: Plug one end of the Ethernet cable into the core switch port and the other end into the access or edge switch port. If connecting two switches directly, a standard straight-through cable is usually sufficient if Auto-MDI/MDIX is supported.

Redundancy and Bandwidth: For critical connections, consider using multiple cables in a port channel to increase bandwidth and provide redundancy.

Network Topology Considerations

Star Topology: Connect all access switches directly to the core switch. This centralizes traffic management and reduces collisions.

Daisy Chain: Less common for core connections, but can be used for sequential switch connections. Ensure proper loop prevention with Spanning Tree Protocol (STP) to avoid network loops.

Between Buildings: Always prefer fiber optic connections for inter-building links, even if distances are short, to avoid grounding issues and future-proof the network.
