

How to connect the fiber optic interface to the switch

Step 3: Install the Transceiver Module Insert the SFP/SFP+ module into the designated switch port. These modules are usually hot-swappable, so the switch does not need to be powered down. Make sure the module is fully seated and secure .

Step 4: Prepare the Fiber Optic Cable Use duplex fiber optic cables with LC connectors (or the connector type compatible with your transceiver). Ensure the connectors are clean and free of dust, as contamination can degrade signal quality . Pre-terminated patch cords are recommended for ease of installation.

Step 5: Connect the Fiber Cable Attach the fiber optic cable to the transceiver module. For duplex connections, ensure the send and receive strands are correctly crossed between devices (A to B, B to A) . If using a patch panel, connect the other end of the fiber to the panel, which then links to the main network.

Step 6: Verify the Connection After connecting, check the switch interface status to confirm the link is active. If the link does not come up,...
