Branch circuits: Connect each branch circuit's live wire to its respective MCB and the neutral wire to the neutral busbar. Ensure the wire gauge matches the load requirements to prevent overheating.

RCCB installation: Connect the RCCB so that it monitors all branch circuits for leakage currents. The live and neutral from the main supply pass through the RCCB before reaching the MCBs.

Cable management: Arrange wires neatly, avoiding sharp bends, and secure them with cable ties or clamps.
