

How to install a fiber optic router online

Step 3: Link the ONT to Your Router Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Configure the Router Access the router's admin panel via a web browser by entering its IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1). Input your ISP-provided credentials to authenticate the connection. Update the router's firmware to the latest version for security and performance. Configure Wi-Fi settings, including network name (SSID) and a strong password. Optionally, adjust advanced settings like QoS, VLANs, or mesh network integration for larger homes or business setups.

Step 5: Test and Optimize Verify the internet speed and connectivity on multiple devices. Place the router in a central location to maximize Wi-Fi coverage. For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi devices to extend coverage.
