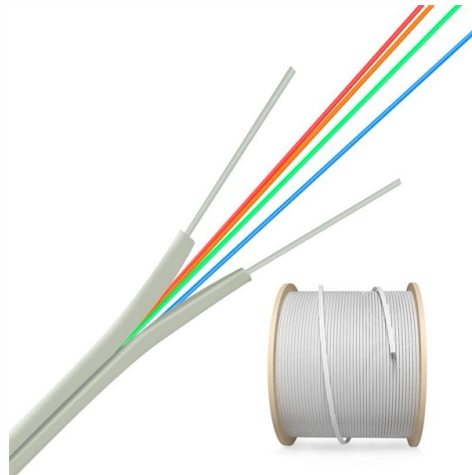


How to pair SFP with an optical module

Verification and Troubleshooting

- Check link LEDs:** A green LED indicates a successful link. If the LED is off or amber, verify power, module compatibility, and cable connections.
- Inspect fiber cleanliness:** Contaminated fiber ends can cause link failures; clean with proper optical cleaning tools.
- Avoid frequent removal:** Repeated insertion and removal can reduce module lifespan.
